**Who can enter?** The contest is open to students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 who are current residents of the State of Hawaii. Students may only enter one division.

**What must an entry include?** An entry must identify an existing problem in Hawaii and offer a thoughtful solution to the problem. **How will students know if they won?** Award winners will be contacted and invited to the awards program (live or virtual) in February 2021.
